Palm Sunday

From the Pastor's desk.

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Brothers and sisters, today we stand at the threshold of Holy Week, experiencing the dramatic tension between the triumphant entry into Jerusalem and the heartbreaking Passion according to Matthew. The same voices that shout "Hosanna!" on Sunday will, by Friday, cry "Crucify him!"

This contrast reveals the fragility of our own faith. Do we follow Jesus only when the path is easy, only when he fits our expectations of a victorious king? In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus rides on a donkey, not a warhorse, subverting our human longing for power and demonstrating that his Kingdom is built on humility and service.

St. Paul tells us to have the same mind as Christ, who emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, obedient to the point of death on a cross (Philippians 2:6-8). Today's readings invite us to follow this King of Peace, even when the road leads through suffering. Isaiah provides our example, setting his face "like flint" toward Jerusalem, trusting in God despite insult and betrayal.

As we hold our palms, let us not be fair-weather followers. Let us walk with Jesus from the Upper Room to the Garden of Olives, and finally to the foot of the Cross. Holy Week is our opportunity to face the truth of our sins—our "Peter moments" of denial and our "Judas moments" of betrayal—and find redemption in the humble, self-emptying love of our Savior.
